

A Home for Dragons






Once upon a time two dragons met on Christmas Island.






They decided to look for a home together.

Next they found a beautiful apartment in East Perth which was nearly perfect, especially the river close by.


But their family was growing with new grandchildren and great grandchildren.






So they found a MUCH bigger house, still in East Perth.
